- Support volunteer Services

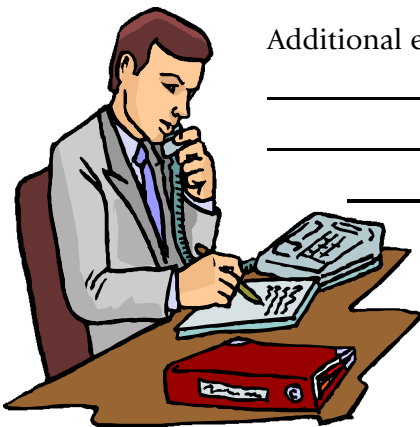
