



Mission of the Church

Prepare students to fulfill the mission of the church by:

a) Showing what Adventists do in the church organization, relating to the subject of HOME ECONOMICS.

Some examples:

Additional examples:

b) Identifying personnel and functions, related to the area of HOME ECONOMICS, that are needed to fulfill the church's mission.

Some examples:

- Ladies who will guide and teach young wives, and young mothers how to have Christian homes in non-Christian neighborhoods
- Young mothers to do out-reach for neighborhood young mothers
- Mothers share techniques to other mothers on how they help boost family income
- Working mothers share Child Guardianship for more economy
- Mothers organize small scale cooperative stores where own products are sold

c) Giving students opportunities and personal experience in witnessing, out-reach and service relating to the area of HOME ECONOMICS.

Some examples:

- Students can go to homes of the elderly to help them with household tasks.
- Students can help burdened mothers with their children for an hour or so.
- Older students mentoring young children from single parent homes
- Items made by students are given as gifts to less fortunate members of the immediate community
- Students participate in feeding programs for the community Day-care Center

Additional examples:

d) Identifying the role and importance that HOME ECONOMICS plays in fulfilling the mission of the church.

Some examples:

- Endorses the family unit
- Promotes cooperation of family members
- Approves healthful living
- Fosters the establishment of Christian families as a light in any neighborhood
- Emphasizes Jesus as the central figure in every family unit
- Encourages a life free from addictions
- Emphasizes simplicity and spirituality in personality development
- Promotes simple, economical, and resourceful family living
