- Translators for local church services
- Translators for radio programs
- Translators for mission work to translate Bibles and books
- Language teachers
- Evangelists
- Preachers
- Editors

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b) Identifying personnel and functions, related to the area of LANGUAGE ARTS, that are needed to fulfill the church's mission.

Some examples:

- Magazine writers
- Language school teachers
- Story writers for reading books
- Writers for TV and radio programs
- Speakers for video and radio production
- Storytellers to make Christian living attractive
- Writers for newspaper religious and educational columns
