Prepare students to fulfill the mission of the church by:

a) Showing what Adventists do in the church organization, relating to the subject of MATH.

Some examples:

Treasurers, Accountants, Auditors, Cashiers, and Pay Clerks that work in schools, churches, and hospitals
Engineers, contractors on building projects file financial statements
Math teachers
Efficient administrators (church and school) with problem-solving skills in operations
Tithing and offering accurately

Additional examples:

b) Identifying personnel and functions, related to the area of MATH, that are needed to fulfill the church's mission.

Some examples:

Local business men who are wise in buying and selling property
Local business men who can buy materials, furnishings for churches, schools, offices
Wise business managers, who can manage the funds of local churches,
Honest accountants, fund raisers committed to the work of God
Christian business people who can exemplify integrity and fairness of God
Financial analysts

c) Giving students opportunities and personal experience in witnessing, out-reach and service relating to the area of MATH.

- Keep accounts for fund raising projects
- Teach other kids how to get their tithe out of their allowances

- Accurate data gathering for evangelistic thrusts

- Descriptive statistics for church growth
