Help the student identify virtues and adopt values by showing links between the subject area and virtues.
The teacher may consider the REBIRTH chart of virtues to help select values that may have links to this subject.

Sign/symbols	Differences in small symbols in math make a lot of difference to to numbers just as little sins are enough to lead us to destruction.	Repentance	Luke 15:7; Acts 3:19; confession and forsaking of sin AA 324
Scales	God has His own time scale and His coming is near. . . even at the door.	Second Coming	Revelation 22:7, 12, 20
Positive integers	Negative integers lower the value of positive integers. Keep your eyes focused on the positive side of life. Look at Jesus and you will radiate a positive influence.	Positive	2 Corinthians 3:18
Place value	Because of sin we are destined to die but He redeemed us because we are of value to Him.	Salvation	Proverbs 20:22; Titus 2:11
Subtraction	God tells us to give Him all our troubles and we will be rested.	Rested	Matthew 11:28-29
