



## Mission of the Church

Prepare students to fulfill the mission of the church by:

a) Showing what Adventists do in the church organization, relating to the subject of MUSIC.

Some examples:

- Compose religious/spiritual songs to be used in church gatherings.
- Direct musical groups formed for worship services
- Form musical groups for out-reach programs for witnessing.
- Teach music classes in Adventist schools.
- Give vocal and instrumental lessons.

Additional examples:

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b) Identifying personnel and functions, related to the area of MUSIC, that are needed to fulfill the church's mission.

Some examples:

- Someone to write a music curriculum that can be used in the Philippine Adventist schools
- Professional music teachers for schools
- Professional SDA singers and composers who are successfully witnessing for God.
- SDA instrumental players in national orchestras.
- Singing groups who go on soul-winning tours and not self-glorification tours.
- Conducting composer or music seminars to teach people how to glorify God with musical talents.
- Piano players for Sabbath services
- Song leaders for Sabbath services
- Add music classes to the college program for Education majors.

#### **MUSIC**

c) Giving students opportunities and personal experience in witnessing, out-reach and service relating to the area of MUSIC.

Some examples:.

- Form singing groups to visit hospitals, nursing homes, orphanages, parks, etc.
- Conduct Branch Sabbath Schools and teaching little kids songs about Jesus.
- Give concerts to raise money for charities.
- Join cultural programs and present religious music.
- Sing at funeral services, prison ministry, and hospitals
- Compete and perform in regional competition.

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d) Identifying the role and importance that MUSIC plays in fulfilling the mission of the church.

Some examples:

- Music, rightly used, gives peace to the soul
- Gospel songs break down prejudice upon hearers of different faiths.
- Music can be used as an avenue for sharing the gospel.
- Gospel truths translated into songs are easily put into memory.
- Music performing groups builds confidence in the performers.
