Spiritual Atmosphere

Create a spiritual atmosphere in the classroom that nurtures Adventist mission, virtues and especially a personal, saving experience with God by:

a) Modeling and voicing spiritual experiences or insights, sometimes personal, showing connections to the subject of MUSIC where appropriate.

Sing for the students and sing with the students Write music for dramas that can be done in class Direct small music groups for school and/or church Lead the music for church services Listen to good music during part of the days
